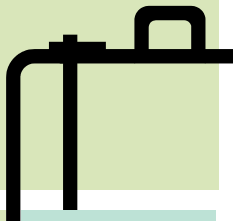


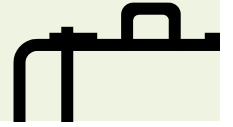

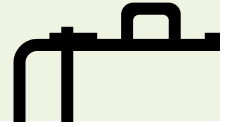
Passport To Leadership



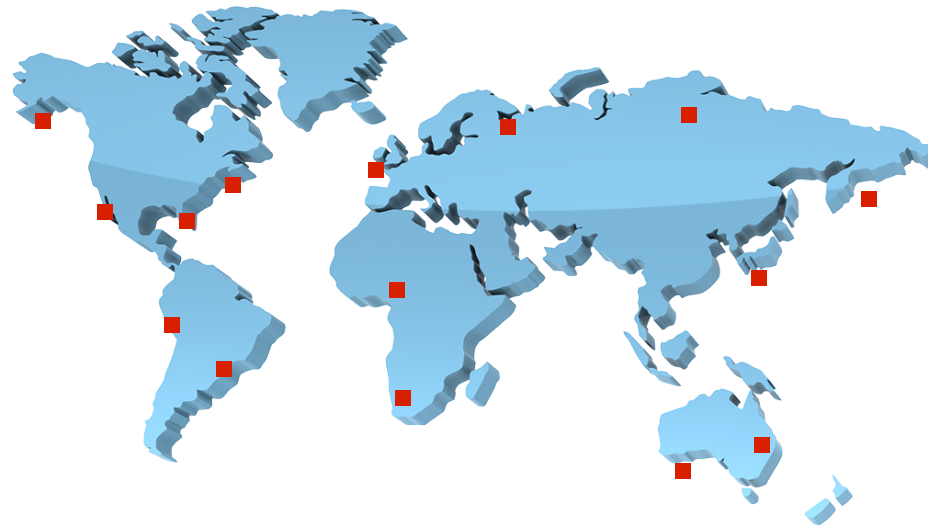
Passport to Leadership is being developed as a guide for young people who are preparing for the road to adulthood.

As we all know, the journey to adulthood can be difficult and dangerous if you are not prepared. It is important to have the knowledge, skills and abilities that will help them for the road ahead.

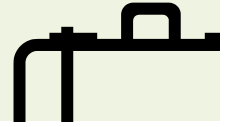

Passport to Leadership has three primary destinations.

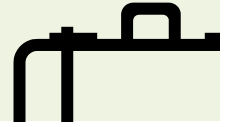
❖ *Financial Well Being*

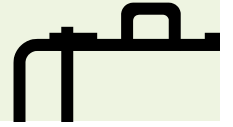


Financial Well Being

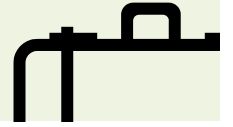


Personal Health and Development

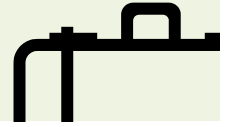

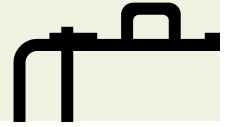
